

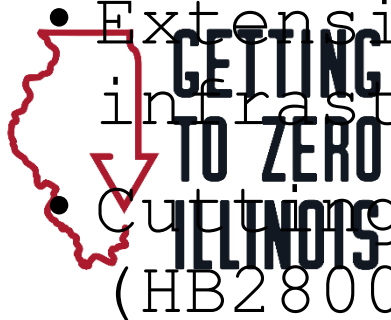
ENDING HIV IN ILLINOIS

- Support services are essential. HIV as #1 priority will change.
- PrEP Clinics > Individual PrEP Clinicians
- Traditional vs. Alternative service delivery models
- STI screening, treatment and empiric treatment

Increase Staff Capacity and Workforce Development

IDPH SFY19 HIV PRIORITIES

- Expand PrEP Demo Sites to additional LHDs, including CDPH
- Align Prevention and Care, where possible
- Leverage Ryan White Infrastructure for HIV Prevention
- Engage CDPH in collar county HIV Prevention strategies
- Simplify Provide Enterprise® invoicing and billing processes
- Expand MHS to identify and prioritize those at most risk
