HOW WE GOT HERE

- **July 2016-Summer 2017** : Informal group met, drafted framework, and got input on framework
- **Informal leadership group met to guide process**
- **December 2017-March 2018**: Held 9 town halls statewide, gathered input through 300 paper and online surveys, and held 9 focus groups with 120 participants
- **January 2018-today**: recruited committee members, co-chairs, steering committee at-large members and formalized the structure



BUT WHAT DO WE MEAN WHEN WE SAY “GETTING TO ZERO”?

- *Zero people living with HIV who are not on treatment*
- *Zero new HIV infections*



“Functional zero” is when there are less than 100 new infections per year and the epidemic can no longer sustain itself.

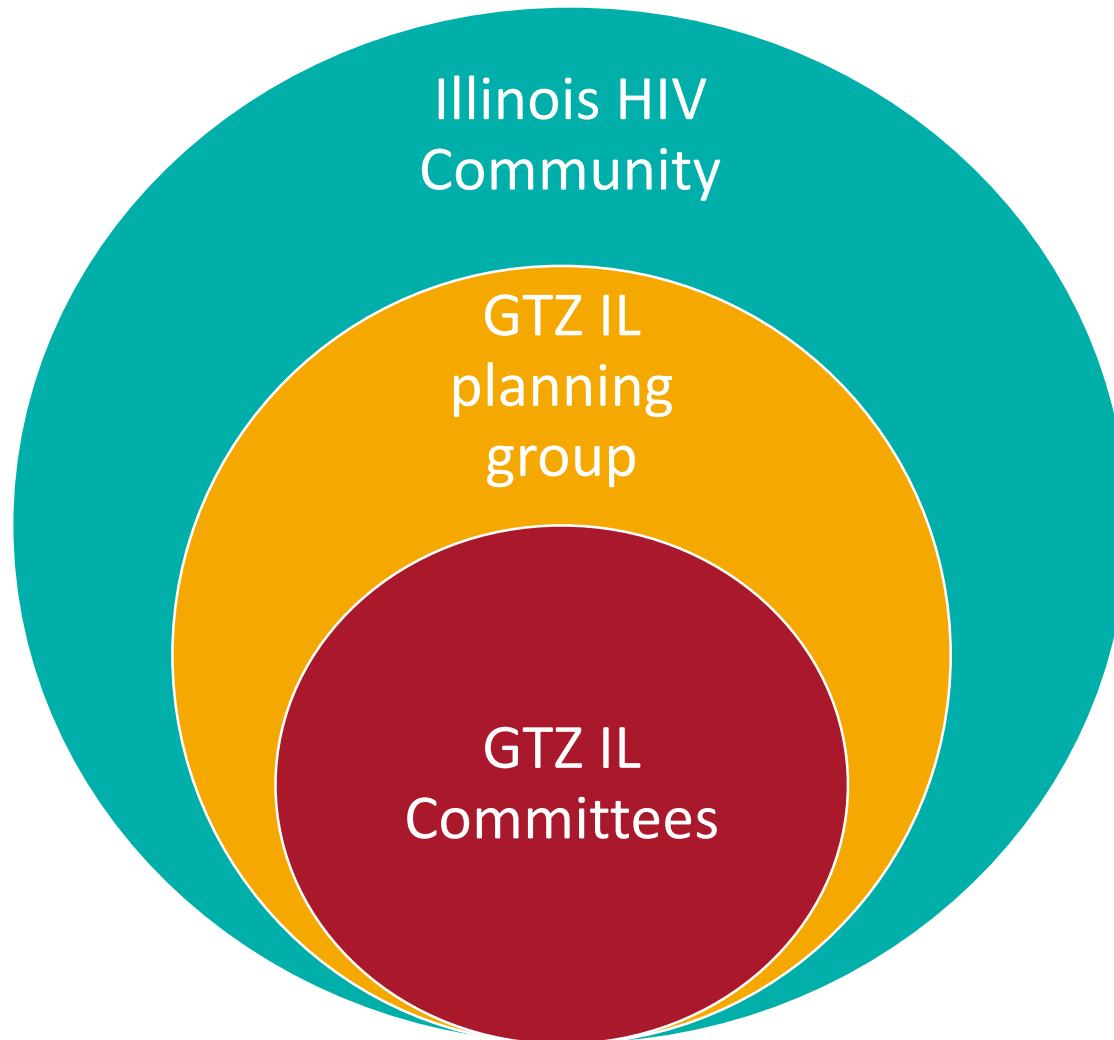
HOW DO WE GET TO ZERO?

- **Increase PrEP uptake:**
 - now 10-20% of people who are vulnerable to HIV are taking PrEP
- **Increase viral suppression:**
 - Now 44% of people with HIV in Illinois and 48% of people with HIV in Chicago are virally suppressed*
